


Ocean Steward Art Contest

Entries must be postmarked by June 30, 2016


Winners will be announced by August 2016 by email and at www.oneillseaodyssey.org/blog

GUIDELINES

1. This contest is open to O'Neill Sea Odyssey participants in grades 4-6. (Immediate family members of OSO staff are not eligible.) **Entries must represent watershed, marine and/or stewardship themes.** A winner will be selected based on their artistic interpretation of these themes learned while attending the OSO program; the winner will receive a family 4-pass gift certificate (\$80 value) for a one-hour public sail aboard the Team O'Neill catamaran. The winner's teacher (named on the Entry Form) will receive two passes (\$40 value).
2. **Artwork must be student's original work.** If using a photo model taken by someone else, image must be significantly altered to avoid plagiarism. **Artwork may not exceed 12 x 18 inches in size.** Acceptable art media are paint, pencil, markers, ink, crayon, chalk or pastel (*fixed*), and collage. Three-dimensional pieces, computer printouts, photography, or photocopies are not eligible. All art entries must contain name, grade and school on the back. A completed Entry Form must also be *affixed* to the back of each piece of artwork. Please do not fold artwork or use paperclips.
3. Through submission of artwork, contestants and their legal guardians grant to OSO non-exclusive reproduction and publication rights to the works submitted.
4. All entries must be *postmarked* by June 30, 2016. Students may enter multiple pieces. Multiple entries (whether from one student or from a group) can be sent in one package, but each entry must have its own entry form attached. OSO is not responsible for entries that are late, damaged, or lost in the mail. The winner and honorable mentions will be announced at www.oneillseaodyssey.org/blog by August 2016.
5. **If you would like to have your artwork returned to you,** please include adequate postage and address label for reuse of original packaging (preferred) or a self-addressed, stamped envelope of the correct size. (Please be sure to pay for USPS envelopes!) *Entries that do not include these items at the time of submittal can not be returned.* Multiple entries may be returned in one package. The winner and honorable mentions may be retained by OSO for approximately six months for public exhibit.
